## **MULTIGENERATIONAL HOME RENOVATION TAX CREDIT (MHRTC)**

The **Multigenerational Home Renovation Tax Credit** (MHRTC) is a refundable tax credit introduced by the Government of Canada to support families who renovate their homes to accommodate multiple generations under one roof. It helps offset the cost of creating a secondary dwelling unit for a qualifying relative.

## 6 CREDIT AMOUNT

- 15% of up to \$50,000 eligible renovation expenses
- Maximum **credit of \$7,500** per qualifying renovation
- Only one renovation can be claimed for a qualifying individual during their lifetime

# WHO CAN CLAIM?

- An eligible individual:
  - Resident of Canada who is a relative of the qualifying individual
  - Owns and/or lives in the eligible dwelling
  - Multiple eligible individuals can share the credit, but the combined claim cannot exceed \$50,000
- A qualifying individual who lives or will live in the secondary dwelling unit:
  - Age **65 or older** at the end of the tax year, or
  - An adult that is eligible for the <u>Disability Tax Credit (DTC)</u>

## HOW TO CLAIM

- File your claim with your personal income tax return
- Use <u>Schedule 12: Multigenerational Home Renovation</u> Tax Credit
- Keep receipts and documentation for all expenses

# WHAT RENOVATIONS QUALIFY?

To be eligible, renovations must create a **self-contained secondary unit** with a private entrance, kitchen, bathroom, and sleeping area. The renovation must be completed in the tax year that the claim is being made.

### Eligible expenses include:

- Goods or services provided by professional contractors, electricians, plumbers, etc.
- Building materials
- Equipment rentals
- Permits and building plans

#### **Ineligible expenses include:**

- Appliances and electronics
- Routine maintenance
- Work done by unregistered family members
- Expenses already claimed under the medical expense or home accessibility tax credits

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## **QUICK TIPS**

- Plan renovations carefully to meet eligibility
- Ensure all contractors are GST/HST registered and provide a written contract & warranty
